

Terms of Agreement

The collaboration agreement is an active agreement for 24 months, starting at the date of signature, that requires a reciprocal exchange as outlined in the above selected criteria. At the date of the collaboration expiration, both parties have the option to renew the collaboration agreement and renegotiate the terms of the agreement. As stated, entering into the collaboration agreement with the IVAT is voluntary and flexible to individual parameters. Both parties are responsible for their organization to do the following: actively promote the other organization in the forms of e-blast notifications, social media and notifications on official website(s) identifying the collaboration and upcoming events. Notifications on social media are required to mention or tag @IVATcenters and use both organizations designated hashtags, IVAT's hashtags are #IVATHelps and #IVATCenters. We do not require a set number of shared content, however we strongly encourage an active partnership. Should either organization not meet the terms of the collaboration agreement for a period of six months the collaboration is considered inactive, with the option to sign a new collaboration agreement in the following year.
